WACE COURSES

WACE Courses in Music Theatre, Acting and Dancing are available from Stage Door. These inexpensive courses take place over 5-6 hours per week for two semesters per year. There are 11 weeks in each semester.

As these courses take place “out of hours”, it is encouraged that students from year 10-12 participate towards their WACE qualifications. Attendance is the main criteria for qualification.

Students in their gap year or after Year 12 have also been successful as a preparation to audition for University Courses.

JUNIOR MUSIC THEATRE COURSE

The Junior Music Theatre Annual Course consists of 3 hours of classes once a week and the Saturday morning production class. The classes consist of Dancing, Singing and Acting. The production class is preparation for a performance of a modestly presented musical at the end of each Semester.

The Saturday morning production class is free, with the course charged at an inexpensive annual fee. (Payment plans are available).

Alternatively, the Saturday morning class is also accessible if students do not wish to do the Course with a fee for this aspect, if taken on its own.

It is envisaged that in the future there will be a major full production, for which all students will be eligible and will be guaranteed to take part.

This major production will be with full set and costumes in a professional theatre. There will be auditions and a limit on numbers involved. This will become a major annual event at Stage Door, with unsurpassed quality and talent from across the State.

It will be necessary for students to be available for rehearsals during the term for the major production, performances of which will take place in school holidays, where this can be arranged.
